HOW DO WE OPERATE?

Sanctuary Christian Camp is led by a team of experienced Christian adult volunteers who are fully trained and supervised. The safety and well-being of everyone at camp is our top priority. All our leaders and volunteers undergo rigorous checks in line with our Safeguarding & Child Protection Policy.

For our volunteers / leaders this includes completing an Enhanced DBS check and providing a reference from a church leader as part of the volunteer application process.

We are a not for profit organisation, and our entire team serves on a voluntary basis, generously giving their time and effort to help make Sanctuary Christian Camp a success.

Several of our core team, the trustees, are 'Camp' veterans, including;

Rev. Stephen Crook. Stephen's first involvement with running Camp dates back to the early 1980's, and he's been heavily involved running the camp ever since. Stephen retired from being a primary school head teacher and is now in full time ministry as the minister of Christ Church in Ramsbottom, after spending many years as a Baptist Minister alongside his teaching career.

Brothers, **Matthew and Daniel** have grown up attending Camp all their lives, first as children and then as leaders. Their Grandad, Jack Pickup, was one of the founders of the original Camp (Goodshaw) in the 1960s which ran successfully up until 2023, before a change in circumstances which ultimately led to the start of Sanctuary Christian Camp. Matthew and Daniel's own children now attend, making them 4th generation Campers.

HOW DO WE OPERATE?

Sarah, our cook, has also been attending camp for many years. First as a child and then as a leader. Sarah's Grandad, John Watson, founded the original Camp (Goodshaw) with Matthew and Daniel's Grandad Jack. Sarah's Grandma, Iris, was the camp cook for many years, until Sarah's mum took over the role. Sarah, although still involved with the ministry and other aspects of Camp, as much as she can be, has changed roles to head up the kitchen after her mum stepped down from the role.

Logan, grew up attending Camp for many years as a young lad before helping wherever possible as a 'young leader'. Over more recent years Logan has been a crucial member of the team and heavily involved with the running of Camp. Logan is experienced in working with children in educational settings, schools and clubs....and has also worked at summer camps in America.

Of course, there are many other people involved in the organising and running of Camp and each play an equally important role.

As we are camping in a field, safety and security are our highest priorities. Campers are accommodated in tents, typically shared by several young people or a family. Adults bringing a Children's / Youth group are housed in adjacent tents to provide supervision and ensure a safe environment.

Leaders patrol the site during the late evening, and even when most of us are off site on a trip, there is always a dedicated team on-site. Recommended ratios of adults to children are always followed and we exceed these. In addition, we operate a comprehensive Child Protection Policy, which is available upon request.

There is ample parking for vehicles in a designated area of the site.

Prior to Sanctuary Christian Camp, a 'Group / Family Leaders Pack' will be sent out to all adults attending and a 'Campers Pack' for all children. These will contain everything everyone needs to know about the week, including the timetable.





MEDICAL




Sanctuary Christian Camp has an experienced, trained first-aider with current certificates and training from one of the national organisations. Others within the Camp who hold a current first aid certificate will be part of a team.

DIET

OD ALLERGENS Our menus are carefully planned to provide balanced, nutritious meals in appropriate portions for campers of all ages. We happily accommodate vegetarians and can cater to special dietary requirements, provided we are informed in advance. It is essential that we are made aware of any food allergies before the start of camp to ensure the safety and well-being of all campers. (See booking form)

EXTRAS

The price shown for Sanctuary Christian Camp is totally inclusive of all accommodation, food and activities. However, there may be an opportunity to purchase little treats like sweets, drinks or small gifts etc. So a little pocket money would be a good idea.







WHO CAN COME?

Church Families - Parents and their children

Parents can bring Children of any age.

Church children's groups - With group leaders

Children attending without parents must be 8 years old or above. The youth leaders or group leaders bringing them must be DBS checked and a reference from church leader provided.

Church Youth groups - With group leaders

Any camper below the age of 18 will be a child / young person. Those aged 18+ will be adults and must be DBS checked and references provided. The youth leaders or group leaders bringing them must be DBS checked and a reference from a church leader provided.

Adult Volunteers

Naturally, our team and all those who wish to volunteer are committed Christians who share our faith and love of Jesus and will be active members of a church fellowship and will be asked to provide two references, one of whom should be a church pastor or leader. In addition, all volunteers must agree to taking out a DBS check through us, or giving us permission to check a previous DBS through the update service.

Accommodation

Accommodation is included and provided for all, in the form of modern '**Bell Tents**'.

Should a family or group require alternative accommodation, please get in touch as we may be able to arrange this by prior agreement.

We have toilets and basic wash facilities on site and our trip(s) to the new local swimming baths are always well received.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

If a group or family booking is made, the group or family leader is responsible for the care, behavior, and enforcement of site rules and curfews for all members of their group, including other group leaders.

Sanctuary Camp is not responsible for any personal property. All campers, including children, young people, group leaders, and team members, must agree to follow the Sanctuary Christian Camp rules. For group and family bookings, it is the group leader's responsibility to communicate these rules to their family / group.

We ask that group leaders and parents participate in meetings and activities alongside their children and young people and attend any adult meetings where appropriate.

For the safety and well-being of everyone at Sanctuary Christian Camp, we reserve the right to refuse admission or send home any individual whose behavior is deemed unacceptable and has the potential to cause damage, nuisance, or harm to others.

Smoking and vaping are not permitted on the main site, and alcohol is strictly prohibited. Anyone found in possession of alcohol will have it confiscated and may be asked to leave.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

We ask that the site is kept as clean, tidy and litter free as possible and upon vacating the site, any remaining litter/rubbish is collected an placed in the bins on site.

*Data Protection

Please note that any personal data provided will be used solely for the purpose of ensuring the safety and well-being of campers. This information will only be shared with camp leaders or medical professionals if necessary.

Occasionally, the contact details provided may be used by Sanctuary Christian Camp to confirm bookings or share information about future camps and related events. Your data will never be shared with third parties outside of these purposes.

*Safeguarding

Please Note: At Sanctuary Christian Camp, the safety and well-being of all attendees is our top priority. Our Designated Person for Safeguarding will take a lead in all safeguarding issues. We take safeguarding very seriously, and all adult camp leaders/volunteers are required to provide/undertake a full DBS check and all adults attending may be required to agree to taking out DBS checks through us.

We have comprehensive safeguarding policies in place to ensure the protection and welfare of every camper. These policies are strictly followed by all leaders and volunteers to create a safe and secure environment for everyone at camp.


HOW TO FIND US
